This two day training builds on the experience of the HOPE group run at TAPESTRY that supports the personal development of participants from non-abusing carers to active protectors of children.

The material delivered on the course is based on the experience gained from the facilitators work with carers who have lived through the impact of child sexual abuse. The course is therefore experiential and aims to connect with the dynamic process and emotions regarding loss and child sexual abuse.

**AIM OF THE TRAINING:** To enhance professional practice in work with non-abusing carers and their families.

### OBJECTIVES OF THE TRAINING:

To enable participants;

1. To consider through discussion and exercise:-
  - a) The material and ideas explored in the HOPE group.
  - b) The dynamic process which participants and workers experience.
  - c) The HOPE group philosophy and value.
2. To provide and explore skills and tools for work with non-abusing carers which affect children and their main carers.
3. To support work to reduce risk to children.
