



She's sort of my friend – we hang out, I tell her stuff and I can trust her. She even helps if I have a problem...



An Independent Visitor? What's that?



We go out



She helps me with my school work



And I can ask her for support at meetings and reviews

She doesn't get paid. She's not a social worker, and she visits me because she wants to. She's a really good mate!
