As part of the new service, Cornwall Council have asked for us to focus on the following:

School support will be focused on primary education to meet the needs of Young Carers at an earlier age and provide the necessary life skills. Secondary schools will also have access to information, practical advice and where appropriate staff support with a particular young person or small group.

In order to facilitate this as effectively as possible, there will be a Kernow Young Carers worker linked with each school across Cornwall so you have a direct contact in the first instance for advice and appropriate support. These workers will contact schools during the Autumn Term.

NEW AND EXISTING SERVICE USERS





FOR THOSE RECEIVING 1:1 SUPPORT PRIOR TO THE CHANGE OF SERVICE, YOUR LOCALITY WORKER WILL BE IN TOUCH WITH YOU SHORTLY TO ARRANGE CONTINUED 1:1 SUPPORT. WE HAVE ALSO BEEN WORKING HARD TO FILL OUR SUMMER ACTIVITY PROGRAMME, WHICH ON THIS OCCASION HAS BEEN ORGANISED FOR THE HIGHER NEEDS CARERS, AS IDENTIFIED BY ACTION FOR CHILDREN. WE WILL UPDATE YOU IN THE AUTUMN TERM TO SHARE OUR PLANS FOR THE COMING YEAR.
