- **1.** Discuss with your child/children which animal they'd like to be and print off the template(s)
- 2. Let your child/children get creative and colour in their mask(s) with pens, crayons, pencils or paint
- 3. Carefully cut out the template

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- 4. Trace the outline of your mask onto cardboard and cut it out - don't forget the eyes!
- 5. Help your child/children glue their mask(s) to the cardboard
- 6. Use a hole punch to make a hole on each side of the mask and loop some string or elastic through, or glue a lollipop stick to the bottom of the mask to hold onto.

- A print out of one of our animal face templates (included in this document)
- Colouring pens/ pencils, crayons or paint
- Cardboard
- Glue
- Scissors
- A hole punch and string/elastic or a lollipop stick.
