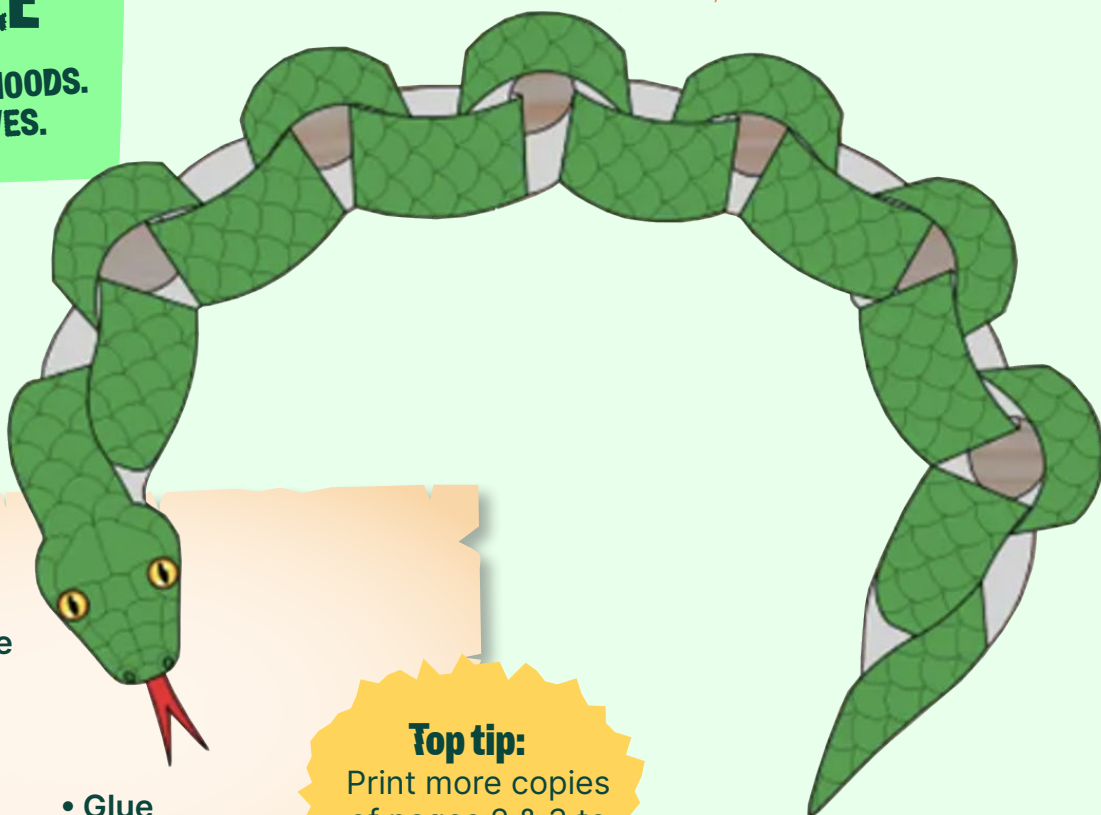

SNAKE PAPER CHAIN ACTIVITY



For this activity
you will need:

- A print out of the snake template (included in this document)
- Colouring pens, pencils, crayons or paints

- Glue
- Scissors

Top tip:

Print more copies of pages 2 & 3 to make your snake even longer.

Instructions:

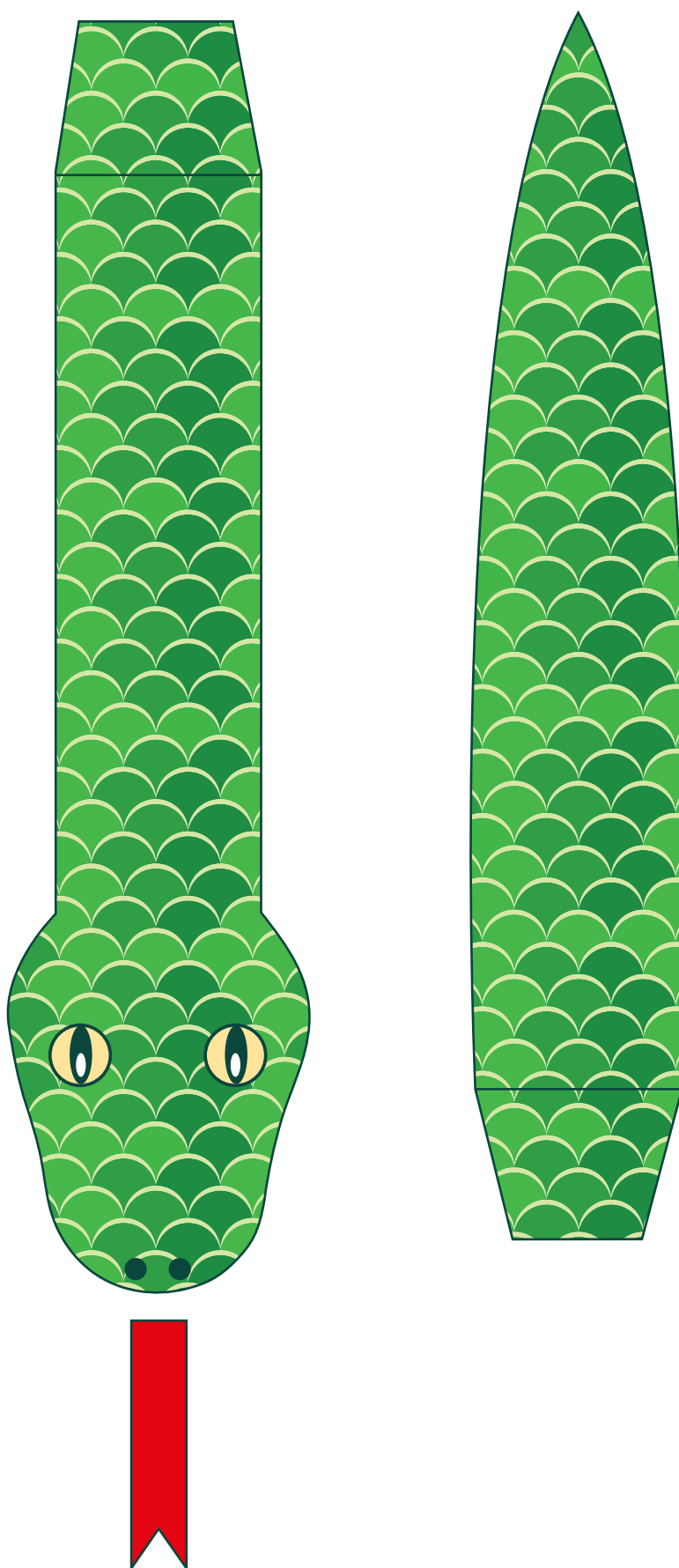
1. Let your little explorer(s) get creative and colour in the snake with pens, pencils, crayons or paint.
2. Supervise and help to cut out the template.
3. Supervise and help to glue or staple the tongue to the mouth end of the snake's head – that's the head complete!
4. To create the snake's body, loop the ends together and glue them in place.
5. Loop the next strip through the first circle and glue or staple – keep repeating this step through the previous circle until you have made a chain and there are no more strips left – that's the body complete!
6. Glue the head to one end of the paper chain.
7. Glue the tail to the other end of the paper chain.
8. Well done – you're ssss-spectacular!

Top tip:

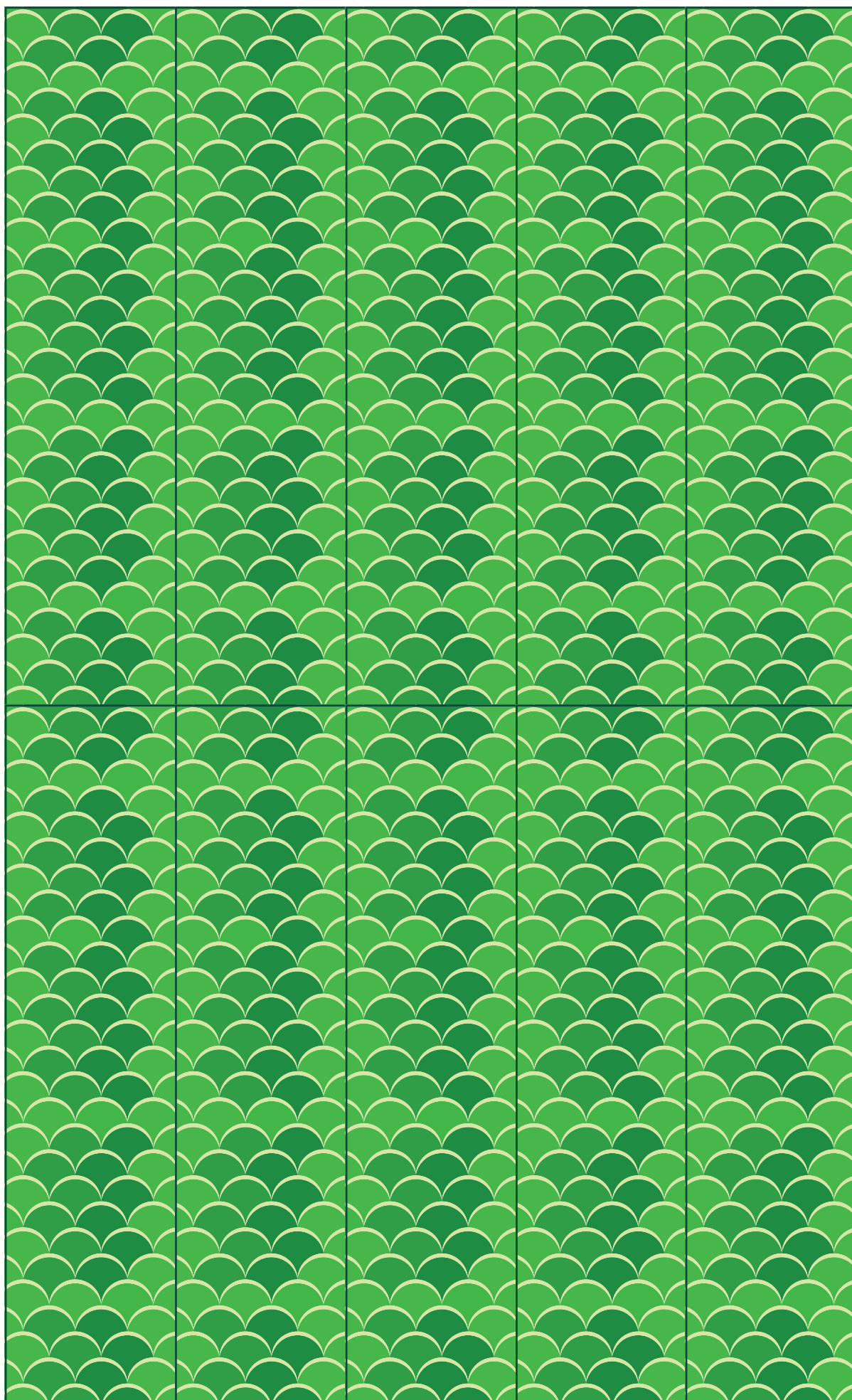
Get your little explorer(s) excited to finish their toddle and use your snake as your toddle finishing line!

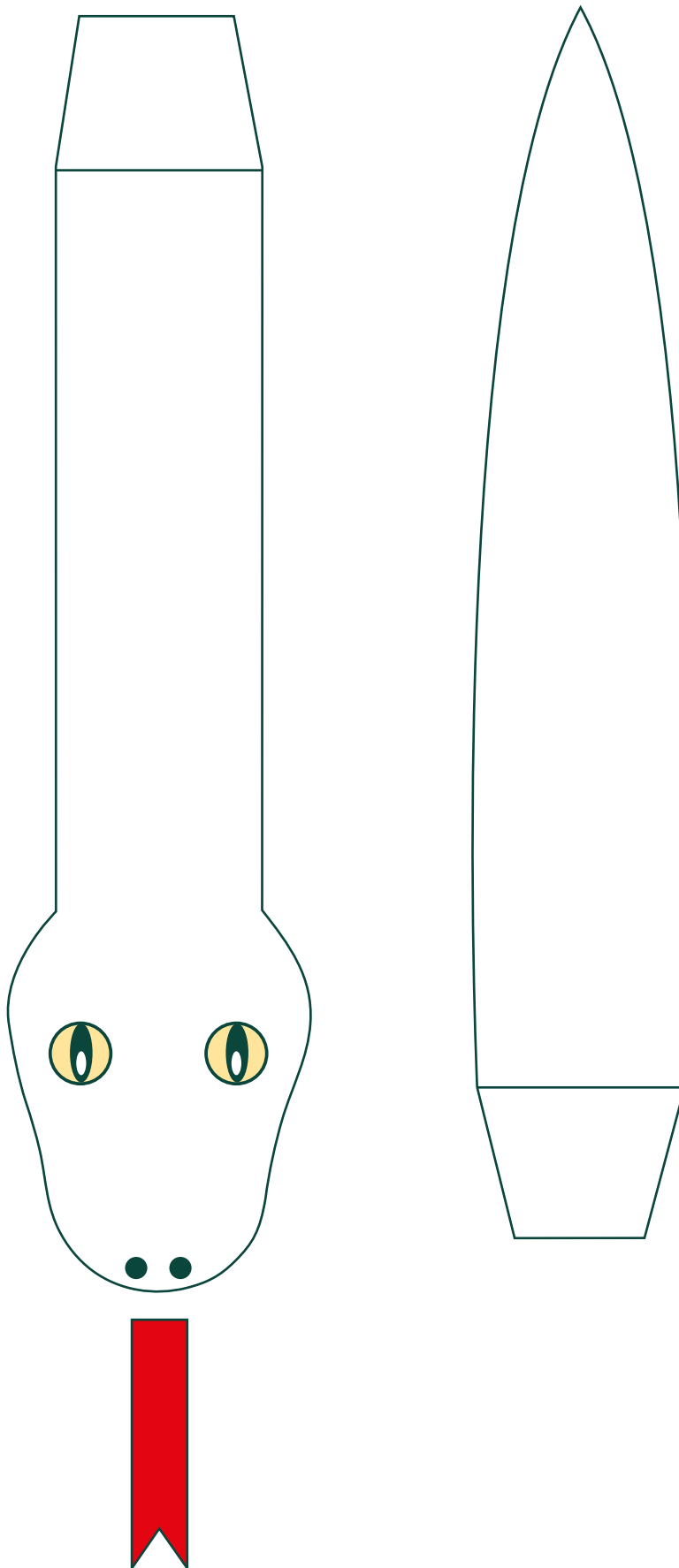
