COSTUMES FOR CAUSE

Costume day: little explorers can dress up as their favourite character for a small donation.

Pviama day: everyone comes in their comfiest pyjamas!

Go Green for Barnardo's: everyone wears green!




Artwork auction: frame or laminate children's artwork and give parents/ carers the option to buy their child's artwork.

Make & sell: handmade cards, decorations, or small crafts created by children.

FUN-FILLED ADVENTURES

Mini games: set up a fun-filled afternoon for children to take part in simple games and races, like a sack race, egg and spoon race or bean bag throwing – a great way to celebrate teamwork and playful competition.

Treasure hunt: a fun adventure for children to follow clues or search for hidden treasure.

Storytime: host a magical gathering where children can share or listen to fun and imaginative stories.

Safari picnic: invite parents, friends and family so their children can enjoy their favourite snacks. Ask for a donation in return.

DELICIOUS DONATIONS

Bake sale: a tasty way to raise funds! Ask friends and family to donate a cake to your sale.

Decorate sweet treats: set up a decorating activity table and ask for a donation to take part – it's chance for children to get their hands messy and choose their favourite flavours. Biscuits or ice cream are great choices!

QUIET CHALLENGES MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE

Read-a-thon: an exciting challenge for children to read as many books as they can while collecting sponsorship.

Sponsored silence: a quite challenge for children to stay quiet for a set time whilst collecting sponsorship.





Jumble or car boot sale: have some unwanted items? Host a jumble sale or car boot and donate the proceeds to your toddle!

Toy swap: host a toy swapping party for children to bring toys they no longer play with and trade them for something that is new to them – it's a great way to share, save money raise funds by asking for a small donation to take part.
