BARNARDO'S HYPE ADVOCACY

Earners of this badge have their skills in advocacy by engaging in a Barnardo's project designed to influence policy, service delivery or attitudes. They will have attended a series of events during which they will have articulated the views of the group they represent and applied the knowledge of their own lived experience in a professional context. They will have consistently utilised their communication skills and contributed to the process in a meaningful way



BARNARDO'S HYPE CO-DESIGN

Earners of this badge have worked alongside health service or social care service leaders to co-design a new service or part of a service. It can also include evaluating a service. The earner of the badge has demonstrated communication skills; used their own experience to generate new ideas and given a young person's perspective. The earner of the badge has worked as part of a team and been part of a managed project setting aims and going through a process from start to finish.



BARNARDO'S HYPE STAFF SELECTION AND RECRUITMENT

Earners of this badge have participated in a recruitment panel for either Barnardo's, The Local Authority or Health Service. The earner of the badge has participated in preparing interview questions; in welcoming applicants; in asking and assessing interview questions. The earner of the badge has worked collaboratively with service leaders to decide on the best applicant for the job.



BARNARDO'S HYPE TRAINING & PRESENTING EXPERT

Earners of this badge have presented staff training programmes or events and will have used their lived experience to contribute to these. They have an improved understanding of a range of issues affecting young people and service users. Earners reflected on feedback and developed training programmes as a result, showed confidence to lead an activity or presentation themselves and understanding of how training programmes fit together and how to create the right environment for good learning.



BARNARDO'S HYPE YOUNG LEADER

Earners of this badge have shown leadership by supporting and mentoring young people, presenting the service to others, and introducing them to groups. They take responsibility for a participation project, including independent communication and partner organisations. They have shown to be confident to lead training groups with young people and professionals. They can contribute ideas and influence service development.
