

The Big Toddle 2027 Terms & Conditions

These terms & conditions apply to Barnardo's Big Toddle (The Event) taking place 7 to 13 June 2027. The Event is promoted by Barnardo's registered charity in England & Wales (216250) and Scotland (SC037605)

By registering to participate in the Event, you agree to abide by these terms & conditions.

Participant Entry

1. The Event is open to UK residents only.
2. By registering for the Event you are agreeing to fundraise for Barnardo's.
3. You will need to register by following the instructions on our [website](#).
4. The Event can be completed in your own time, and we hope you can join in during Big Toddle week, 7 to 13 June 2027, however, do feel free to organise a Big Toddle at a time that is convenient to you and your little ones. We may provide tips on how to stay safe whilst completing Big Toddle, please read these and ensure to comply with them.

Use of Logo

5. Written consent must be sought from us prior to you using any Barnardo's or associated logo. If you wish to obtain an 'in aid of Barnardo's' logo, please email Big.Toddle@barnardos.org.uk to contact us.

Fundraising

6. You will only use lawful means to fundraise and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm Barnardo's reputation.
7. You must comply with any fundraising guidance or advice issued by Barnardo's and abide by the [Code of Fundraising Practice](#) issued by the Fundraising Regulator.
8. My fundraising **will not** include:
 - a. Raising funds by carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections.
 - b. Collecting funds in any public place without first obtaining written permission from Barnardo's, a licence from the local authority and any other licences or consent as required by law and the Fundraising Regulator's Code of Fundraising Practice.
 - c. Collecting funds on private property (including shops, pubs etc.) without first obtaining written permission of the owner of the private property.
 - d. Conducting any raffle or lottery without first contacting Barnardo's and following any steps required by Barnardo's.
9. Barnardo's can terminate my authority to fundraise in aid of the charity at any time by sending written notice to the email or postal address I provided at the point of registration.

Donations & Payment Terms

10. Any monies raised in connection with Big Toddle are held on trust for Barnardo's. All participants have a legal responsibility to ensure that all sponsorship monies/donations raised in connection with Big Toddle are paid to Barnardo's by:

Online Giving Page: Collect donations through an online platform, such as JustGiving. Most platforms will automatically transfer funds to the charity, but please check the platform you are using.

Phone: Call 0300 003 2025 to make a payment using a credit or debit card or request our bank details to pay by BACS. Please have your Barnardo's reference number (starting ORN or SRN) handy.

Post: Send your cheque(s), made payable to Barnardo's to: Barnardo's Big Toddle, Tanners Lane, Barkingside, Ilford, Essex IG6 1QG. Please do not send cash through the post.

11. Funds raised in connection with the Event must be paid to Barnardo's within 30 days of you completing the Event.

12. You will make clear to everyone supporting your fundraising that you are raising funds **in aid of** Barnardo's.

13. Where applicable, participants will only use sponsorship forms issued by Barnardo's and completed sponsorship forms must be returned to Barnardo's no later than 4 weeks after completing the event.

14. You will make it clear when fundraising in connection with the Event, that the money is not given subject to any conditions and that the funds will not be returned if the Event is cancelled.

Use of your information

15. We will use information provided by you when registering for the Event for the purposes of administering the Event, and Barnardo's may also contact you to discuss your fundraising and follow up on your progress.

16. Only provide personal information on behalf of additional event participants if they have confirmed that they are happy for you to do so as we will use this information for the same purposes outlined in clause 15.

17. The personal information provided by you when registering for the Event may be used for the purpose of sending you communications in line with the consent given when registering for the Event.

18. All personal data held by us will be handled in accordance with applicable privacy laws and [Barnardo's Privacy Notice](#).

Liability

19. Nothing in these terms limits any liability which cannot legally be limited, including death or personal injury caused by negligence.

20. By registering for the event you confirm that you understand that the activities and/or events organised by you to raise funds in aid of Barnardo's are your responsibility, including but not limited, to all costs and liability. Barnardo's bears no liability whatsoever for any events and/or activities you may organise. Barnardo's shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss to me, my property or to any third party that might occur because of the fundraising activities and/or events that you organise.

21. You enter the Event entirely at your own risk. Barnardo's shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss to you or your property that might occur as a result of your participation in the event, other than in respect of any injury or loss arising as a result of our negligence.

22. You must ensure that you have obtained consent from the owner of any privately owned land or premises at which you choose to carry out the Event, and that you have all relevant licenses, permissions and public liability insurance in place prior to your activity taking place.
